



## Douzelage Susice - Activities May 2009 – April 2010

1. 8<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> June 2009 25 children from Basic School Lerchova and Gymnasium Susice attended the sports stay ADEPS 2009 in Houffalize. Before the stay they joined an e-mailing project with the other participants from Granville, Sherborne and Marsaskala.
2. In June 2009 the Kammerchor of Kötzing, Svatobor Choir and Children Choir of Susice had two successful concerts performing Carmina Burana by Orff after several common rehearsals in Bad Kötzing and Susice.
3. 2<sup>nd</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> July 2009 10 students of the Gymnasium Susice took part in the one week long project called MAMI (major minorities) in Köszeg, Hungary.
4. 25<sup>th</sup> July – 1<sup>st</sup> August 2009 a group of four students participated in the Global Warming project organized by Bad Kötzing at the Wilderness Camp Am Falkenstein
5. In October 2009 choir Kammerchor Judenburg visited Susice to have a common concert with Svatobor choir and accompanied a mass in our local church.
6. In February the class 1.A took part in the project „Up Together“ in Waldmünchen with pupils from the Realschule Bad Kötzing.
7. 20<sup>th</sup> March 2010 a preparatory choir Vcelky of the Susice Children Choir performed at Musikparty in Bad Kötzing
8. 8<sup>th</sup> - 11<sup>th</sup> April three children and two teachers from Basic School Lerchova in Susice took part in Miniparliament in Belagio
9. Grammar school students hosted students of Realschule Bad Kötzing on the canoeing trip and at the skiing course.

We have worked hard on preparation this general meetig. Besides applying the EACEA agency for subsidy to organize this GM and providing technical issues for this event, we have published a series of articles about Douzelage activities in the local newspaper.

To improve awareness of Douzelage association we have prepared a quiz competition about Douzelage towns for Sušice citizens
